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Our Soul Centre Vision

Royal Chosen Christian Church Soul Centre exists to restore and revive lives through the Gospel of Jesus Christ, make disciples, raise Christian leaders, and demonstrate the love of Christ through practical service to our community and surrounding regions.

Our vision is to develop committed followers of Jesus Christ who will become disciple-makers and reach communities with the transforming message of the Gospel.

Our Mission

Our mission is to:

Win souls, make disciples, equip Christian leaders, reach underserved communities, and demonstrate the compassion of Christ through spiritual and practical outreach.

We desire to become a centre for discipleship, leadership development, evangelism, community outreach, prayer, pastoral care, and Christian service.

1. Youth Discipleship and Leadership Development

One of the major ministries of our Soul Centre will be the training and equipping of young people to become committed disciples and disciple-makers.

Our community has many young people with the potential to serve God and positively influence others. Through biblical teaching, mentoring, prayer, practical ministry experience, and leadership development, we desire to raise a generation of Christian leaders who will carry the Gospel to others.

We will seek to train young people to:

- Develop a personal and growing relationship with Jesus Christ.
- Understand and apply the Word of God.
- Become effective witnesses of the Gospel.
- Make and mentor other disciples.
- Develop Godly character and Christian leadership skills.
- Participate in evangelism and community ministry.
- Respond to God's calling for ministry and service.

Our desire is in line with 2 Timothy 2:2:

“And the things that you have heard from me among many witnesses, commit these to faithful men who will be able to teach others also.”

We believe that disciples should raise other disciples, and leaders should raise other leaders.

2. Reaching Unreached and Underserved Island Communities

Our Soul Centre intends to develop an outreach and discipleship ministry focused on reaching communities in and around the islands of Lake Victoria.

We desire to train and mobilize young disciples and Christian workers to take the Gospel to areas that may have limited access to consistent Christian discipleship and ministry.

Our areas of outreach may include island and lakeshore communities such as:

- Dolwe
- Bukakata
- Nondwe
- Kiyindi
- Lwanika
- Other unreached or underserved communities around Lake Victoria.

Our approach will include:

- Evangelistic outreach.
- Discipleship and follow-up of new believers.
- Prayer and pastoral care.
- Bible teaching.
- Leadership development.
- Establishing discipleship groups and Christian fellowships where appropriate.
- Identifying and mentoring potential local Christian leaders.

Our desire is to obey the Great Commission of Jesus Christ:

Matthew 28:19–20 — “Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations... teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you.”

We believe that geographical challenges should not prevent people from hearing the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

3. Community Outreach and Compassion Ministry

Our Soul Centre recognizes that Christian ministry involves both proclaiming the Gospel and demonstrating the love and compassion of Christ.

Jesus cared for the spiritual, physical, and practical needs of people. Therefore, we desire to serve vulnerable members of our community with dignity, love, and compassion.

A. Support and Care for People Affected by Leprosy

Our community faces challenges involving people affected by leprosy.

The Soul Centre desires to participate in compassionate outreach by connecting affected individuals and families with appropriate medical services and support, while working responsibly within the guidance of qualified health professionals and relevant authorities.

Our ministry will seek to:

- Encourage affected individuals and their families.
- Reduce stigma and social isolation.
- Connect people with appropriate healthcare services where possible.
- Provide prayer, pastoral encouragement, and practical support.
- Mobilize the Christian community to show compassion and dignity.

Jesus demonstrated compassion toward people affected by leprosy, as seen in Mark 1:40–42.

We desire to communicate that every person is valuable and worthy of love, care, and dignity.

B. Supporting Orphans and Disadvantaged Children

We desire to support orphans and children from disadvantaged families within our community.

Depending on available resources and partnerships, this ministry may include:

- Providing scholastic materials.
- Assisting with school fees.
- Providing basic educational supplies.
- Offering encouragement and mentorship.
- Supporting families and guardians caring for vulnerable children.

Our desire is inspired by James 1:27:

“Pure and undefiled religion before God and the Father is this: to visit orphans and widows in their trouble...”

We believe that education can provide hope and opportunity for vulnerable children.

C. Supporting the Elderly

Our Soul Centre also desires to extend practical care to some of the most vulnerable elderly people in our community.

Where resources permit, we hope to provide:

- Food assistance.
- Home visitation.
- Prayer and spiritual encouragement.
- Fellowship and companionship.
- Practical support according to identified needs.

We believe that elderly people should not be forgotten or isolated.

Proverbs 19:17 reminds us:

“He who has pity on the poor lends to the Lord, and He will pay back what he has given.”

4. Evangelism and Discipleship

The Soul Centre will remain firmly committed to the central mission of the Gospel.

Our activities will include:

- Personal evangelism.

- Open-air and community outreach.
- Home visitation.
- Special groups evangelism meetings like Market Vendors, Bodaboda riders, Capenters etc
- Prayer ministry.
- Bible study.
- Discipleship groups.
- Mentorship.
- Christian leadership development.
- Encouragement of believers to discover and use their spiritual gifts.

Our goal is not only to see people make decisions for Christ, but also to help them grow into mature and reproducing disciples of Jesus Christ.
